FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS

Bromsgrove maintains a number of places for Foundation Scholars. These awards only operate in respect of day places and preference is given to candidates from Bromsgrove and stherounding area. Foundation scholarships are usually awarded at 11+ dB+ and are then held for the remainder of the S X S tinte at School.

Foundation scholarships are awarded to very able pupils in need of financial assistance. The maximum award is 50% of the day fee (mean sested), which may be augmented by a further mean sested bursary.
